Please follow the steps below to make your booking:

- 1. Go to our school website at <u>oakeyss.eq.edu.au</u> and click on the "Parent Teacher interview bookings" link under Quick links
- 2. Enter your email address. You can have your bookings emailed to you.
- 3. Enter your name. You can also enter a contact phone number so we can call you if we need to.
- 4. Enter your child's first and last name and select their year level. If you have more than one child, you will be able to enter them on the next screen.
- 5. Click on the "Add child" button to add all of the children you wish to have interviews about. Then click on the "Book Interviews" button beside each child to book interview times. Do not forget to click "Save" after choosing a time. Green times are available slots. Greyed out slots are already booked. When you book your second or third child's interview, the previous bookings will show in pink to help you choose timeslots close together.
- 6. After booking an interview, the button next to your child shows "Adjust interviews". This will allow you to go back in and click on a booking to cancel it and change it to another time. As bookings fill, you may need to go back and forth to find and adjust your bookings for multiple teachers so that they are close together.

When you are done, you can click on the Email Schedule. Bookings close midnight Sunday night, September 3.
